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Legislation NOT passed that Could Have Impacted JJAEPs, DAEPs and School Safety



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Education Legislation that did not pass:

NOT PASSED

HB62	Alt to Suspension/Advisory Council for Restorative Justice
HB97	Charter Schools can deny entrance if DAEP/JAEP orders exist
HB108	Charter Schools to have same rules for expulsion/suspension
HB144	Special Ed programming – supplemental needs 2019-2021
HB256	Workplace bullying – parents can be reported policy
HB411	ARD changed to IEP –Individualized Education Program
HB612	First & Last Day of school changes



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Education Legislation that did not pass:

NOT PASSED

HB640	Parental consent searches exempted from expulsion
HB759	Threat assessment teams and Student Database reporting
HB1468	May operate an online only instruction option
HB2278	Re-Write of Chapter 37.007- regrouping offenses
HB2295	Commissioner’s Court and JJAEPs
SB1109	Vetoed – seemed repetitive; no ‘parents getting to opt out.’ may be presented in special session



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Legislation passed that Impacts JJAEPs, DAEPs and School Safety



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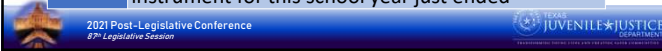


Education Legislation Passed:

PASSED

HB 785 Behavior improvement/intervention plans required with a change in placement to DAEP or JJAEP; reporting restraints (aligns with JJAEP standards)

HB 999 Relating to use of individual graduation committees for certain high school students; not required to consider criteria under Subsection (h) relating to performance on an end-of-course assessment instrument for this school year just ended



Education Legislation Passed (Continued):

PASSED

HB 1252 Special ed. due process hearings must follow federal timelines (20 U.S.C. Sections 1415(b)(6) and (f)(3))

HB 1788 School security personnel - immunity from liability for reasonable actions in course of work

HB 2721 Prohibiting student from extracurricular activity for assault of sports official



Education Legislation Passed (Continued):

PASSED

HB 3456 JJAEPs - exemption from future budget cuts

HB 159 Improving training and development for educators Section 9- Special Ed Training required

HB 246 Educator Inappropriate Relationships; cannot release name of school employee until indicted



Education Legislation Passed (Continued):

PASSED	
HB 3597	School safety - no more than eight drills & rules from TX School Safety Center
HB 4545	Accelerated instruction for students who don't pass certain tests: 3 rd , 5 th , and 8 th
SB 123	Instruction in positive character traits and personal skills in public schools



Education Legislation Passed (Continued):

PASSED	
SB 168	Emergency school drills; establish best practices; and added active threat exercises info
SB 348	Parental access to public school virtual instruction and instructional materials
SB 741	Allows concealed carry and storage of weapons on school property by security personnel



Education Legislation Passed (Continued):

PASSED	
SB 797	Schools mandated to display <i>In God We Trust</i> if donated or purchased from private donations
SB 1267	Continuing education for educators and school district personnel re: academics, cybersecurity and educating students with disabilities
SB 2050	Strengthening policy and practice re: Bullying and cyberbullying
